Breeders comments

With Australian grain growers facing the environmental challenges of frost, heat and drought, it is more important than ever for farmers to be equipped with a range of variety maturities to help spread risk.

Condo (VX1634) is one of the fastest maturing varieties on the market and the best performing 'quick' maturing variety. Its early maturity means it is very well suited to short season environments or where sowing is delayed, and where increased risk of heat stress and below average spring rainfall may limit the yield potential of slower maturing varieties.

High temperatures at flowering coupled with below average rainfall in spring has substantially impacted yields in recent years. Having a quick maturing variety like Condo allows the plant to be physiologically advanced and yield potential set prior to the potential onset of both drought and heat shock. Having this maturity option helps minimise risk associated with these environmental constraints.

Condo has expressed excellent adaptation to central and southern NSW as well as northern Victoria due in part to its acid soil tolerance. This along with its strong grain package expressing low screenings and high test weights make it a great choice for growers in the south eastern region.

Seed Availability

Condo is able to be traded between growers upon the completion of a License Agreement as part of AGT's Seed Sharing initiative.

PBR and EPR

Condo is protected by Plant Breeders Rights (PBR) and all production (except seed saved for planting) is liable to an End Point Royalty (EPR), which funds future plant breeding. Condo growers will be subject to a Growers License Agreement that acknowledges that an EPR of \$3.25/tonne + GST has to be paid on all production other than seed saved for planting.
